Oneida Chapter National Society Daughters of the American Revolution is inviting high school seniors to participate in the Maude Foley Scholarship. The scholarship is named after a generous oneida Chapter member who left the funds to be used for a student who plans to attend a two or four year college or university. **One** scholarship of **\$1,000** will be awarded.

Last years' recipient was Mark Polk from Whitesboro High School.

But there is more good news:

The scholarship winner will then be eligible to compete at the State level for one each of four additional scholarships:

New York State DAR Scholarship, a \$2,000 award of \$500 for four years.

Helen and Arnold Barben Scholarship, a \$2,000 award of \$500 for four years.

Damaris Smith Desimone Scholarship a one-time award of \$1,000.

Peggy Jo Power Gifford Scholarship, a one time award of \$500. (This has stipulations that an individual be majoring in United States History, Philanthropic Studies or Non-Profit Management)

Since the State level scholarship deadline is February 15, 2021, we must assign our deadline as January 15, 2021 in order to enter the Maude Foley Scholarship winners in the state competition.
